

Dover school enrollment expected to reach 3525

Dover senior high students will begin the new school year Wednesday, Sept. 6, at 8 a.m. Principal Robert W. Schrock announced today.

Students should report to their home-rooms immediately upon arrival. Home-room lists will be posted Friday at 4 p.m. at the front entrance on Walnut st. Students are encouraged to check these before Wednesday.

Each student will be given a handbook and a copy of the new dress code the first day. Schrock requests students and parents to read these so they can become aware of the rules and procedures of the school.

THE SENIOR HIGH Student Council will sponsor an orientation program Friday at 10 a.m. for 10th through 12th grade

students new to the Dover system. A tour of the building and an opportunity to become acquainted with other students will highlight the session.

Study hall exemptions will begin Sept. 25 if all necessary paperwork has been completed. All students assigned to eighth or ninth period study halls must report to them prior to this time.

No schedules will be changed to provide students with an eighth or ninth period study hall. This also includes those desiring the time to be exempt for employment purposes. Schrock emphasized, "At Dover senior high education comes first. I suggest those students having employment register for one of our cooperative programs such as Diversified Cooperative Training; Cooper-

ative Office Education or Occupational Work Experience."

THROUGH COOPERATION with New Philadelphia High School, Dover is offering vocational welding for five students. Interested persons have until Sept. 8 to enroll in the program.

Schrock stated no class schedules will be available for students until the first day of class. He requests that students and parents not call the school asking for this information.

Vacation will end a day earlier for staff members. Teacher convocation will be held Tuesday at 9 a.m. in the high school cafeteria. Dr. Maurice Williams of the University of Akron will be the speaker.
