

Dover senior high students will begin new term Sept. 5

Dover students will begin classes Sept. 6. Junior and senior high school classes will begin at 8 and elementary classes at 9 with the exception of Dover Avenue school which begins at 8:45.

Students who have not previously attended Dover schools are asked to register during the remainder of this week. Principals' offices are open in each of the buildings Monday through Friday from 8:00 to 4:30.

Students are asked to delay purchasing school supplies until after the first day of school when teachers will send home suggested lists with each elementary child. Secondary course requirements will also be made known at that time.

Cafeterias at the Junior-Senior High School and East, Park and South elementary schools will be in operation on opening day. There have been no changes in the cost of lunches since last year. The high school "Class A" lunch will cost 45 cents, lunches in the elementary schools will cost 35 cents each day.

It is anticipated that approximately 3525 students will be enrolled in the Dover schools this year as follows: Dover Avenue, 330; East, 475; Park, 590; South, 370; junior high, 880, and senior high, 880.

Teachers new to the Dover schools will meet in an orientation session Friday. Paul Koval, curriculum director, has planned a full day of activities to prepare them for the opening of school. All teachers will participate in Convocation Day Tuesday, when the final preparations for the beginning of the new school year will be completed.

Each Wednesday the elementary schools will dismiss at 2:45 instead of the usual time. This earlier dismissal will provide teachers with time for in-service activities. The junior and senior high school will have a late start on six days during the school year for the same purpose.

Bus transportation will be provided this year for all high students living more than a mile from the high school. It is hoped that in addition to providing transportation for students who have to walk more than a mile, traffic around the high school will be decreased because parents will not need to drive their children to school and that fewer students will need to drive. The school bus loading area has been changed to Walnut st.

Because of the complicated scheduling involved in transporting kindergarten students, parents have been notified by letter as to the school his child will attend and the time of pick up.

Any parent of kindergarten children who did not get a letter, or any parent who has a question about the following elementary and high school bus routes is asked to call Donald W. Peters, administrative assistant (343-7748).

School bus routes for this year have undergone considerable changes. Listed below is each of the school buses, the driver, and specific points along the route to be traveled.

The times listed are approximate only. Allowance must be made for arrival which may be a little earlier or later until definite schedules are established. In-town pickup points are indicated by the corner at which the bus will stop (Iron av. and Grant st.). The first street listed is the street on which the stop will be made.

Some buses have more than one high school route. Where this occurs the first route to school will be the first route home in the afternoon. A student must ride the same route each way.
