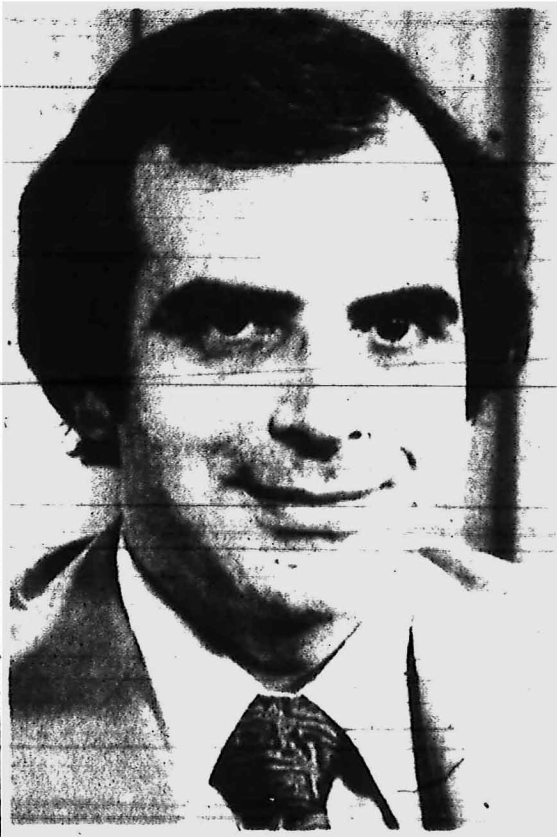


Thomas Monios, new GM at Phila's Joy plant

Joy Mfg. Co. of Pittsburgh has named Thomas Monios general manager of its New Philadelphia Division.

He succeeds William F. Cramer of New Philadelphia who had held the post since 1975. Last year, Cramer was designated senior vice president of Joy in charge of its general products and petroleum equipment groups.

Monios will report to Cramer, who continues to be based in New Philadelphia. He also will be responsible for Joy's Alpha Fan Division in Winnipeg, Canada.
