The scholarships range from \$1,500 to \$2,000 and are renewable if the recipient maintains satisfactory academic progress and demonstrates good college citizenship. Malone is a four-year Christian liberal arts college affiliated with the Evangelical Friends Church, Eastern Region.

The scholarship recipients were chosen on the basis of their high school cumulative grade point average, ACT test composite score, Christian commitment and leadership qualities.
