

Dessecker to end Dover board tenure

Eugene Dessecker of RD 1, Dover, an eight-year member of the Dover board of education announced last night he will not be a candidate for re-election in November.

In announcing his decision Dessecker said:

"After much thought my decision not to run is due to additional community obligations and family responsibilities. I regret that I will not be a member of the team whose responsibility it will be to mold the future educational program of the Dover schools.

"My most rewarding experience of public service has been my years as a member of the Dover board of education. I wish that every citizen might have the opportunity to enjoy this same experience. I wish the administration and the board much success in the years ahead."

A similar decision was announced last week by Atty. Richard Hanhart, an 11-year member of the board.
