

Dover school calendar set for 1974-75

The calendar for Dover schools was approved by the board of education Monday night. There will be 180 days for elementary schools, 181 days for secondary schools and 185 days for teachers.

Schools will open Sept. 4, 1974, and close June 11, 1975, with teachers' record day on June 12. The schedule includes Thanksgiving recess Nov. 28 and 29; Christmas and New Years holiday, Dec. 20 to Jan. 6, and spring recess, March 21 to 31.

Transfer of funds from Title I to the general fund and from capital outlay and contingency to NDEA projects were approved.

Reports on the status of the school paper, "The Crimsonian," and on the special education program were given by Paul Koval, director of curriculum, and Howard Denison, school psychologist, respectively.

In other business the board:

—ACCEPTED the resignations of Larry Gillaspie, Beverly Royer, Alice Travis and Eleanor Krause.

—APPROVED the appointment of Norma Viers and Robert Lyon to the teaching staff for 1974-75.

—APPROVED the appointment of Kathleen Evan as 7th and 8th grade girls' track coach at a stipend of \$150.

—ACCEPTED the appointment of Theresa Schroeder, Janet Caldwell and Herbert Garber to the substitute teachers' list.

—APPROVED attendance at professional meetings for a number of administrators, teachers and employees.

The meeting was recessed to April 22 when teachers' contracts will be discussed.
