Dover board

asks dismissal of damage suit

The Dover board of education has filed a motion in common pleas court to dismiss all or a portion of a suit filed against the board by Charles Beckley Jr. of RD 3, Dover.

Beckley is seeking \$30,210 damages for an injury he received in an industrial arts class which resulted in the amputation of a finger on his right hand.

The motion, filed by Dover Solicitor John Woodard on behalf of the board of education, asks for a dismissal of the entire action because the complaint fails to state a claim against the board.

Secondly, it asks for dismissal of the portion of the complaint asking for \$10,000 punitive damages, because the complaint fails to state the facts upon which it could be granted.

The accident occurred June 7, 1972. Named in Beckley's suit are the board of education, Supt. Bill Kinneer, Principal Robert Schrock and Paul James, industrial arts instructor.
