Dover school audit lists one citation

A summary of the audit of the Dover schools, which is on file for public inspection in the office of Norma Hardwidge, clerk-treasurer, shows only one citation — for a technical violation.

The examination, conducted by state examiner Ralph Hill, covers the period from June 1, 1972, through Nov. 30, 1975.

The technical error was that the board of education carried a deficit in a fund account. Money has to be transferred to such accounts, because deficits are not permitted.

Although the summary did not contain any specific findings, a 3-cent bank error was noted in the body of the report.

The summary stated that the audit of accounting records and supporting files reveals continuing efforts of officials to conduct business transactions according to law and within guidelines set by the bureau of inspection.

"It also noted that the clerk-treasurer has maintained records in the recommended manner and on the prescribed forms.
