1896 NPHS Football Team

“The Origins of Football”

In the Beginning 1896-1901

Football was slowly growing in popularity, and since the new rules “modernized” the game, more colleges and secondary schools started participating in the sport.

Locally, although the records before the turn of the century are very sketchy, the first known high school football game played in Tuscarawas County happened around November 17, 1896. New Philadelphia hosted Canal Dover at the baseball diamond at Tuscora Park.

A recount of this historic game is taken from the Nov. 19th issue of “The Tuscarawas Advocate.”

The sport-loving people of New Philadelphia and Canal Dover were treated to a magnificent game of football at the baseball park last Saturday afternoon, between the teams of the New Philadelphia high school and the Canal Dover high school. Consequently, it was not up to the highest standard, but taking everything into consideration, the game was a fine contest.

Captain Andrews won the toss and chose the north goal. The opponents took the ball and made a fine kickoff, but Olmstead secured the ball and by good dodging and fast running carried it nearly to the center of the field.

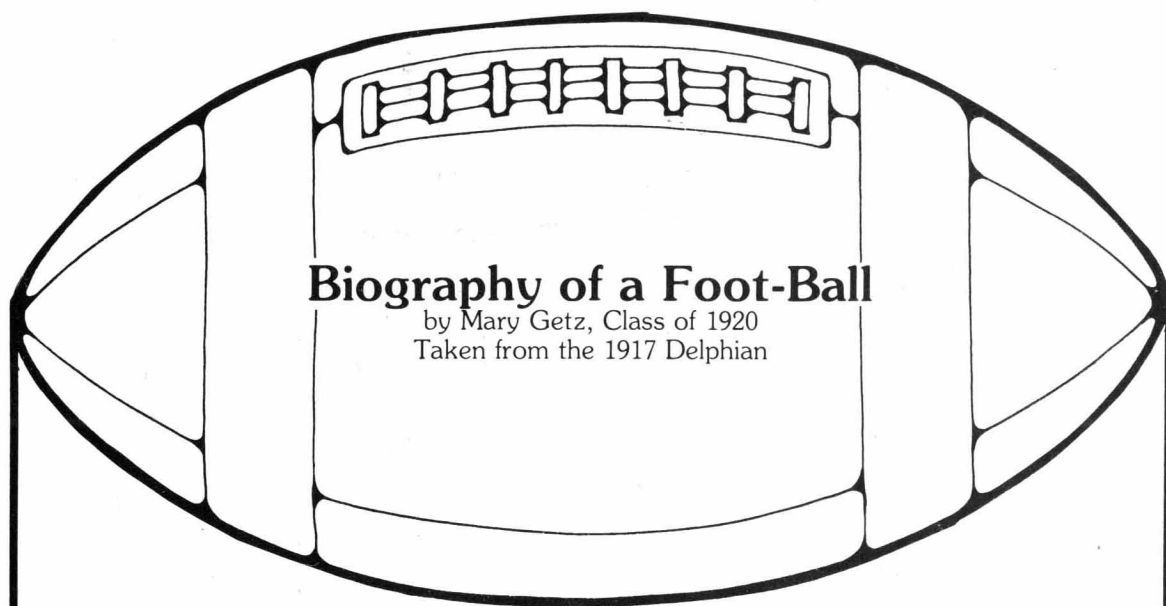
The home team adopted new tactics at this point and bucked the line for big gains...the first half ended with the ball in Dover territory, neither side having made a touchdown.

The second half opened with the ball in the home team’s possession and the first touchdown was made eight minutes after the kickoff by Jacobs; Williams kicked goal. Double passes fooled the visitors considerably, and they apparently did not know what to do when Fullback Wilken bucked the line. Wilken made two touchdowns near the end of the game, and Williams kicked two difficult goals dead against the high wind that was blowing. The game ended 18-0, in favor of the New Philadelphia high school.

In 1897, again the only available score is the game between Dover and New Philadelphia. The Red and Black defeated Dover for the second year in a row by the score of 13-0.

For the next three years, again there are no scores available. However, in 1901, the records show that New Phila and Dover were at it again. This time around they met twice. In the first contest they played to a 5-5 tie, each team only collecting one touchdown. In the second game, Dover defeated the Red and Black. The record book shows that they won by a score of 11-0 which must have been taken from the Dover paper the “Iron Valley Reporter” because our local paper, then called the “Democrat Times,” gave this account of the game. “Last Saturday afternoon the “friends” of Dover met eleven young players from New Philadelphia on the gridiron at Canal Dover and defeated them 6-0. The game was called at 2:15 and after the kickoff the ball was fought over in the middle of the field, with Dover having a slight advantage. At the end of the first half New Phila quit and referee Muckley awarded the game to Dover.”

By this account Dover would have won by a forfeit. Whatever the score, 11-0, 6-0, or by a forfeit 1-0, Dover still recorded its first victory against a New Phila team.



Biography of a Foot-Ball

by Mary Getz, Class of 1920
Taken from the 1917 Delphian

My first recollection of true life was in A. G. Spaulding & Company's factory in New York City. I had been packed into a small dark box with quite a few of my relatives and brothers.

One day in August, one of the shipping clerks took me down from my resting place upon a dingy, dark shelf and placed me in a large box bound for some distant home. I was then put into an auto truck, and later loaded into a car, little knowing where I was bound for.

One fine day a few weeks later, I arrived at my destination which was, much to my surprise, New Philadelphia. I had often heard the clerks speaking of the town. I was put into George E. Buss' show window and the lid taken off my head. This pleased me very much, because I could see the people as they went by.

One day a short stocky man came in to look at some foot-balls. I was taken from my place in the window, with a few of my relatives, and much to my delight, was purchased. I learned later this young man was head coach of the New Phila. High School team, and that I was to be used in the greatest game of the season between Dover and New Phila.

I was given some of my favorite food, the boys say "pumped up" and was used in very light practice to shape my body.

The big game was near at hand and I became a very good friend of all who handled me. I made up my mind I would do my share in bringing the honor to old New Phila. High.

The day of the game was rather exciting. Every one seemed full of joy, crowds were cheering, and poor little me placed upon a mound of dirt on the forty-yard line all by myself. Soon the whistle blew, and both teams came rushing toward me. All of a sudden I was kicked into one of the Dover players' arms, but not for long as I was crushed beneath a mass of gridiron warriors. I was then anything but a fine looking foot-ball. My sides were covered with mud and water, and I soon became rather chilly, but never did I forget my one desire to do all in my power for N.P.H.S. I was run back and forth on the field. Several times New Phila. was about to place me over the goal for a touchdown, but something usually happened to disappoint me.

They treated me rather roughly during the entire game, throwing, kicking and falling upon me, which was not very pleasant, but I knew I must do my share.

When the final whistle blew for the big game to be over, I was certainly a tired-out ball; and if my eyes did not deceive me, I think the fellows were worn out too.

The game ended in a nothing-nothing score, and I had not done my share. I was taken back to the High School Building and put in my old bed with a few of my worn-out brothers. I will have a long rest until next season, but I hope that I will be able to see this one big desire of mine accomplished.

In addition, Kaserman serves as Vice-President of the Ohio High School Golf Coaches Association and is Editor of that organization's statewide newsletter.

"Probably the greatest thing to ever happen to Quaker golf in the past five years is the addition of Gary Miller, P.G.A. Pro, and former Quaker and Collegiate All American player, as assistant coach of the Quakers this fall," according to Kaserman. Gary is the owner of Green Valley Golf Course and one of three former Quaker Golfers to earn their P.G.A. cards.

Phila Improves to 7-2 On a Wing and a Prayer

New Philadelphia got a new coach, a new offense and new hope for the future to start the 1982 football season.

Ward Holdsworth, formerly head coach at Newcomerstown for 13 seasons, returned from three years of self-induced retirement to succeed Jim Roman as head coach at his high school alma mater.

Holdsworth discovered that he did not have a quarterback in the upper two grades who appeared to be a strong passer. Enter the single wing offense, in which quarterback Chad Bailey became a blocking back.

After a shakey start, the wing took hold and has been the driving force in five consecutive victories and a 7-2 record.

While Bailey calls the signals and leads the blocking, look for fullback Al Ledrich and tailback Steve Watson to do most of the running.

The center snap goes directly to either Ledrich, "Mr. Inside," or Watson, "Mr. Outside"...the Quakers two top ground gainers. Joe Lowery and Matt Dummermuth also get into the act as Phila runs a variety of power sweeps, the dive series, inside and outside reverses, double reverses and triple reverses. Almost every play has a pass that can be thrown off it.

The Quakers can also go to the "T" formation with Bill Amick most likely to handle the ball under center.

Obviously, the running game is Phila's strong point, but don't be surprised if you see a long aerial strike from any one of the backs to one of the other backs, or to ends Mike DeMattio and Joe Tucker.

Dover Takes Surprising Dip to 6-3

With the likes of quarterback Mike Bayer, halfback Mickey Mamarella, middle guard Eric Mills, linebacker Jack Edwards and tackle-placekicker Todd Altier, the Tornadoes were expected to claim their fourth Cardinal Conference crown and make a run at the Division II playoffs.

But, while these blue chip seniors were returning, Dover had to rebuild most of its line and backfield. It cost them three losses in the process, but tonight's visitors seem to have it all in the groove now.

Under coach Bob Maltarich, the Crimson uses a multiple attack from a variety of sets. The strong point is the use of a lot of misdirection with Bayer faking and throwing effectively.

Mamarella, moved from wide receiver to halfback, is still Bayer's favorite target on passing downs, but also look for Rick Braglin and Dave Polce to catch a few.

After some searching, Maltarich finally settled on Steve Cox at fullback and Bryan Miller, a sophomore, as the other halfback. Both have improved immensely over the past few weeks and are Dover's answer to the inside-outside rushing game.

Bayer is rated a strong, accurate passer, but if he is flushed from the pocket, he just might run. He is a three-year starter who has learned to adjust instantly to most situations.

This just might be the most evenly-matched Phila-Dover game in some time.

The winner takes a share of the Cardinal Conference crown with Wooster.
