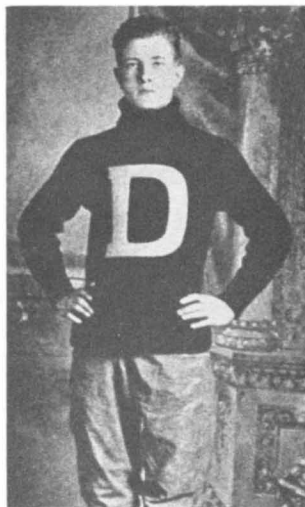

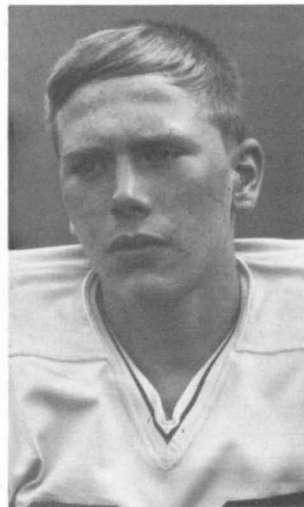

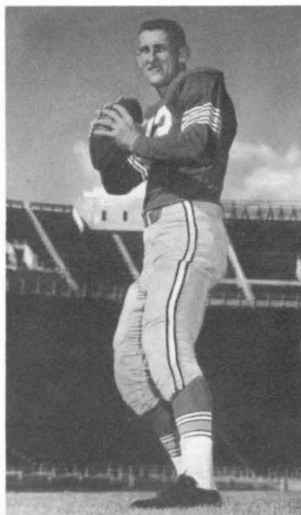

## IN REMEMBRANCE

The Tornado Club wishes to remember Richard F. Trustdorf, the most valuable player in the Dover-New Philadelphia 1968 contest, won by Dover 26-0.

During his high school career, Trustdorf was known not only as a pin-point passer, but an active, running quarterback who gained chunks of yardage on the quarterback keeper play.

Former Coach Dick Haines always said one of the keys to success of the undefeated 1967 campaign

was Trustdorf's emergence as a quarterback. This enabled Haines to keep Dave Keitch at the running halfback position and provided more firepower at both halfback and quarterback.

As a youngster, Trustdorf was a member of the famed Dover Basketeers and later attended Ohio University and Muskingum College.

Trustdorf died tragically the morning of May 5 in a mobile home fire at his residence at RD 5, New Philadelphia.





**DWIGHT HUDSON—OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY DRUM MAJOR**

**SPECIAL GUEST** Dwight Hudson was born May 22, 1957, in Columbus, Ohio. He started baton twirling at six years of age. Dwight was unique in that he began marching with the high school band in the fifth grade.

In 1976 Dwight became the Ohio Boys' State Champion Twirler and in the same year he placed seventh in the World Championship held at Notre Dame University. Dwight's 1976 appearances included performances at the World Series, Kentucky Derby and for the American Freedom Train.

To fulfill a childhood dream, Dwight received the appointment as the Assistant Drum Major in 1976. He has also been the Ohio State Drum Major for the years

1977, 1978, and 1979. As Drum Major in 1977 he performed at the Orange Bowl, and in 1978 at the Sugar Bowl and the Gator Bowl. Also, last Fall Dwight was the featured twirler and performer for the Pittsburgh Steelers football team.

Dwight has appeared in numerous television specials including PM Magazine, Pulse, Afrotation, and a special entitled "Dwight" for the major television networks. More recently, Dwight has served as Honorary Chairman of the Central Ohio Chapter of Multiple Sclerosis. He has involved himself in such civic projects as Creative Living and Muscular Dystrophy.

Dwight is a communications major at Ohio State University and hopes to enter the profession of public relations after graduation.

The New Philadelphia High School Band was organized in January, 1915, by Frank R. Speck, Director of music. The band started out as an (all male 40 piece unit). On May 30th, they made their marching debut when they

played in the Memorial Day Parade.

Since then the school band has become an established institution which is filling a big place in the school and community activities.

What style of band is the New Philadelphia Marching Quakers today? They take pride in patterning themselves after today's fine modern drum and bugle corps.

The drum corps tradition in America dates from the military life and drum units of the American Revolution, through the bugle bands of the early 1900's to the modern drum and bugle corps. The latter has evolved into the most disciplined and precise audio visual display of musical pagentry in existence anywhere today.

The pagentry of a corp style marching band combine the military precision of West Point, the musical blend and excitement of a well-directed symphony orchestra, and the showmanship of a Broadway musical.

This year Mrs. Graham, (our director for the last five years), has been keeping the "Marching Quakers" very busy. They have been competing almost every week-end since August 18th.
