

# Dover's wet field is due to rain: NP has only pot luck tickets left

New Philadelphia Athletic Director Mike Benedum says only general admission and standing room tickets remain for Friday's season-ending football game in Dover. They can be purchased at Tusco Sports for \$2.50 each.

Benedum said fans holding white reserve tickets will sit in the permanent stands on the visitors' side of the field. Blue ticket holders' seats are in the bleachers at the west end. Yellow ticket holders will sit behind the east end zone, or scoreboard end of the field. Yellow tickets say "east and west end zone," but seating was split to permit both benches a good view of the scoreboard.

At Barr Drug in Dover, 150 reserved tickets remained to be sold as of 9 a.m. today. They are for seats in the east end zone.

Standing room tickets will go on

sale when the reserved seats are gone. All tickets are \$2.50. Barr Drug will be open until 6 tonight and until game time tomorrow.

Meanwhile, the Times-Reporter received calls Wednesday that the Dover Fire Department snorkle truck had been seen "sneaking" into Crater Stadium.

A couple of years ago, there was some controversy over a field being "watered down," but any mud on the floor Friday can be blamed on Mother Nature.

The snorkle was lent to the Dover Jaycees, who were putting up a new flag pole rope. "We haven't had a flag-raising at the stadium all year," one club spokesman said, "because somebody keeps stealing the rope."

He promised the Jaycees would keep a careful watch on their project until game time
