

Dover boys, Phila girls win in junior high track battles

The Dover and New Philadelphia boys and girls junior high track teams met Thursday at Crater Stadium, and two exciting matches were the result. The Quaker girls triumphed 55-50, while the Dover boys won 68-51.

Many school records were set. In girls' action, Susan Pryor of New Philadelphia ran the 400 in 65.2, while Dover's Cindy Atkinson mastered the 800 in 2:39.7, both records. The Quaker 1600 relay team of Sue Stocker, Tammy Gow, Ginelle Hunter and Linda Pryor set a new standard with a time of 4:36.5, as did the 800 relay team of Michelle Miller, Stocker, Hunter and Carol Meehan.

There were two double winners in girls' action. Atkinson also tied in the 1600 along with her 800 victory, while the Quakers' Sue Canfield triumphed in both the shot put and long jump.

In boys' action, not only did Dover's Dave Van Epps win the high jump, but he broke the school mark in the long jump with a leap of 18-4½. Dover 7th grader Leroy Phillips set a new standard in the mile with a time of 5:03.2, while his fellow runners broke the old mark in the 1600 relay with a time of 4:03.6.

Matt Dummermuth was a double winner for the Quaker boys. He triumphed in the hurdles and 400.

Dummermuth was the high jump winner and Rick Gallagher took the mile when the Quakers were defeated 69-40 Wednesday by Coshoc-ton.

The Dover boys are 8-0 in dual meets, while the girls are 3-4.

The New Philadelphia boys conclude their season at 5-5, while the girls are 6-4.
