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MADOX'S 46.47 ANCHOR LEG HELPS JOHN ADAMS TO 1,600 RELAY RECORD, 3:13.79; KIRKHAM AND ORRE ALSO SET ALL-OHIO MARKS

Performances around the state took a noticeable upswing last week and more is due this weekend when athletes move into nine regionals to determine qualifiers for the state meet finals, June 1-2 in Columbus.

Three all-time Ohio records were set last week, Laura Kirkham of Centerville posting 44.0 in the 300-meter low hurdles, Kristy Orre of Northmont clocking 4:51.71 in the 1,600-meter run and Cleveland John Adams blazing 3:13.79 in the 1,600-meter relay at the Cleveland Heights AAA District.

Kirkham is no stranger. She holds the all-Ohio long jump record and is a multi-talented athlete. Orre, a junior, already has many achievements as she seeks a distance double at the state meet.

Adams broke the previous all-Ohio 1600 relay record of 3:14.6 set by Dayton Roth in 1982. Harold Madox, who won the open 400 in 46.9, anchored the "Running Rebels" relay by posting a 46.47 leg. Juniors Paul Thomas, Melran Leach and Donald Taylor joined Madox.

Were the Rebels shooting for a record?

"No, we were not because Thomas and Madox had just run the 200 qualifier," said Adams' Coach Claude Holland. In Saturday's finals,

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Adams won the 1600 in 3:13.9 and Madox repeated his 46.9.

Adams now owns Ohio's fastest times in the 1,600 and 800-meter (1:26.7) relays and shares first with Akron Buchtel in the 400 relay (42.0).

Defending AAA state 1600 champion Rollie Hudson posted twin victories, 1:54.7 for the 800 and 4:20.4 for the 1,600-meter run.

At the CWRU District, Mike Huber of Cleveland St. Ignatius, the defending state champion at 800 meters, won his specialty in 1:55.3 and he anchored St. Ignatius' 3,200 relay to a meet record 7:49.4.

Springboro coach Larry Hefflin said his team would be a contender for its district crown and not the state as reported last week. And it did turn out that way as Dayton Jefferson qualified 13 individuals and three relays for the Dayton Regional this week. Jefferson won the district with 124 points. Springboro had 92.
