## DAYTON ROTH RUNNERS SHATTER 2 ALL-OHIO RECORDS IN 800 AND SHUTTLE HURDLES RELAYS

Dayton Roth was in rare form at the Dayton Relays last Friday night when the "Purple Crush" set alltime Ohio records in the 800-meter relay and shuttle hurdles.

Roth, winner of the state Class AAA crown last year and now setting its sights on the AA title since the school dropped to that class this season, clocked 1:26.5 in the 800 event to break the old mark of 1:28.7 set by Cleveland Heights in 1980. Roth bettered the shuttle hurdles all-Ohio mark by two tenths of a second with 55.3.

Roth currently has the state's leading 1,600-meter relay clocking of 3:24.0 and 3,200 with 8:05.9, plus holding numerous other top marks on Ohio Track & Field News' state Honor Roll.

On the distaff side, Bridgette Ray of Orrville assumed a big lead in the shot with a put of 44-2. That bettered the existing state meet mark of 40-1 1/4 set in 1980 by Tamara Lee Sayre, Marion Elgin. Upper Arlington recorded the swiftest 3,200-meter relay clocking in the Dayton meet with 9:40.8. The Arlington girls won that event in the state meet last year with a record of 9:21.04.

## CLEVELAND HEIGHTS SWAMPS BELLAIRE FIELD WITH RECORD 100 1/3 POINTS; FOUR MARKS SET

Cleveland Heights ended Lancaster's three-year reign as champion with a resounding victory in the 28th Bellaire Relays, piling up a record 100 1/3 points last Saturday. Runnerup Columbus Wehrle had 47 points as four records fell and another was tied.

Heights started its sweep of all five running relay events with a 42.9 victory in the 400. The Tigers also won the 3,200 relay with 7:56.1, the shuttle hurdles with 56.3 and 800 with 1:29.4.

"I'm really happy to win a big one like this for the first time," said Heights Coach Dick Mann, in his 21st year at Heights.

For a while Mann and his team of 16 received a scare enroute to Bellaire when this van blew a tire. But that blowout was nothing like the number the Tigers pulled off on the star studded field.
