Ohioans Show Fine Early Form, Set 3 Alltime Records

Kirkham Spans 19-4½ for All-Ohio Record

The unusual wet and cool spring everyone seems to be having does not seem to affect Ohio's track stars. With the season barely under way, three alltime Ohio records have been bettered and a number of outstanding individual marks have been posted as evidenced by the first honor role which appears in this issue.

The all-Ohio records:

Laura Kirkham of Centerville in the long jump, 19-4½, breaking the old mark by one-quarter of an inch. The old record was held by Brenda Morehead of Toledo Scott and set in 1974.

Cincinnati Princeton, 1:31.1 in the sprint medley relay (100,100,200,400), topping the old mark of 1:31.6 set by Middletown in 1980.

John Adams in the 1,600 medley relay (400,200,200,800), 3:31.8.

The boys' all-Ohio 100-meter record of 10.3 set by fabled Jesse Owens of East Tech in 1932 and tied by five others may be the next one to be broken.

Newest challenger is Toledo sophomore Wayne Boyd, who ran a wind-aided 10.2 two weeks ago. Then, last week, Boyd suffered a pulled left hamstring and could not compete in the Mansfield Relays. He may be ready for the district meet, leading up to the state.

Another of Ohio's premier sprinters who missed the Mansfield carnival was Jim Glasco of Columbus West, still out with a pulled hamstring which he suffered at the end of the indoor season.

Mike Huber of Cleveland St. Ignatius, Ohio's defending AAA 800-

meter champion, is off to a fine start. Huber, who signed a national letter of intent with Georgetown, won his specialty in 1:54.3 at Mansfield.

Dunbar's Michael Jackson turned in two super efforts in winning the 110 high hurdles (14.3) and 300 lows (36.9). He also anchored his team's winning shuttle hurdles to a record 59.1. Detroit's Anthony Mahone won the 100 (10.5) and 200 (21.4).

Sandusky Perkins has one of the finest AA teams in the state. Last year Perkins won the district and regional titles and placed fifth in the state meet. Key people are Mark Speer, state runnerup in the high jump last year and distance aces Scott Fry, a junior, and senior Brian Martin.

Versatile Susan Nash of Zanesville Rosecrans has picked up where she left off last season after leading her team to the girls Class 'A' title. Her best early marks are 12.8 in the 100, 58.8 in the 400 and 2:18.6 in the 800. Transfer Chris McGee gives Rosecrans added strength in the sprints.

Columbus Wehrle is one of the state's Class A powers and will be a threat for the state crown in June because of the one-two punch of sprinters Jerry Francis and Steve White and hurdlers Lewis Nowlin and Steve Washington. White is also a ranking high jumper and long jumper in the state.

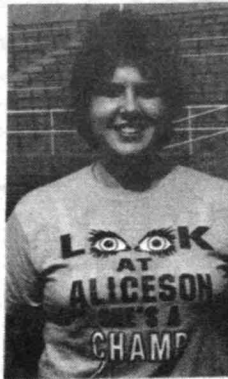

Owens Classic countdown Byers status is uncertain

COLUMBUS - Tom Byers, former Ohio State distance star who ran the first sub-four minute mile of 3:57.15 in Ohio Stadium in winning last year's mile at the first Jesse Owens Track and Field Classic, is still on the fence regarding his participation in this year's meet. It will be held Sunday, May 6.

At presstime, Meet Director Ron Althoff still could not get a confirmation from the former Buckeye runner that he would be back to defend his title.

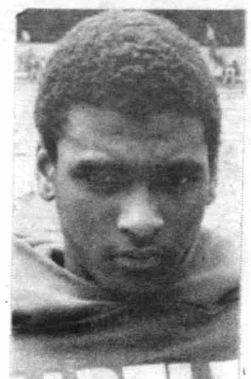
