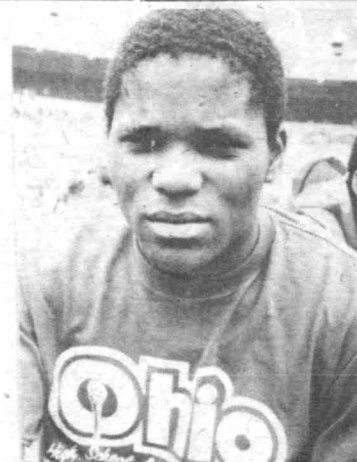

BEDFORD CHANEL RUNNERS POST FASTEST 1600 RELAY THIS SEASON, 3:20.4

Bedford Chanel flexed its muscles to make a run at the state AA title next month when the Firebirds ran the fastest 1,600-meter relay in the state this season, 3:20.4, at the 51st Mentor Relays.

Chanel also has Cecil Washington atop the 400 rankings with 49.9, and Kevin Henderson in the lead in the 300-meter low hurdles with 37.7.

In Class AAA, Bob Mau of Rocky River registered a fine distance double victory, taking the 1600 in 4:24.4 and the 3,200 in a state-leading 9:22.4 at the Comet Relays.

Tony Tonti of Mentor is the second vaulter in the state to clear 14 feet this season. He did it in a

dual meet at Bedford last week. Bothered by a sprained ankle, Tonti only cleared 12-feet at the Mentor Relays.

Jeff Doughty of AA Southeast also has scaled 14 feet this season.

Some dazzling marks were posted last Friday at the Dayton Relays at Welcome Stadium. In the 1600 relay, Cincinnati Princeton won with 3:22.0 over Dunbar, 3:22.3. Dunbar also had 55.6 in the shuttle hurdles and 1:32.6 in the sprint medley.

In that same meet, Upper Arlington's girls took the state AAA lead in the 1600 relay with 4:07.5 and the 3200 relay on 9:53.4.

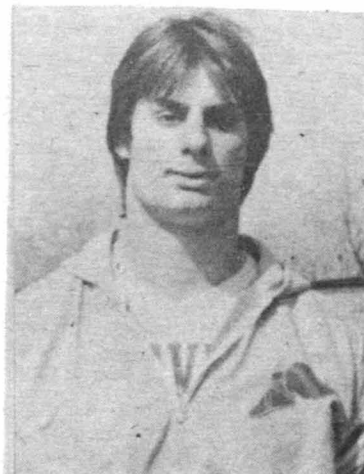

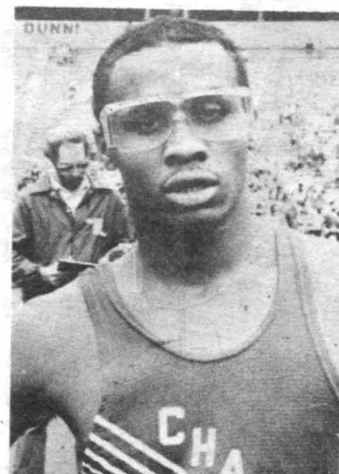
