Barry Walker Sets All-Ohio Shot Record with 67-10 3/4

Barry Walker of Lancaster broke the all-Ohio record in the shot put twice and Kevin McBroom of Columbus Wehrle equalled the all-time Ohio 100 meter dash record with 10.3.

Walker, who has left a trail of records during a star-studded career, had 66-8 1/4 at the Miami Relays May 1. He had 67-2 1/2 last Tuesday in the COL meet, and last Saturday broke it again with 67-10 3/4 at the Fulton Relays.

Walker bettered the all-Ohio mark of 66-5 3/4 set by Ken Lanier of Columbus Marion Franklin in 1977.

Walker's series in COL meet boarded on the fantastic as he averaged 65-6 1/2 for his six throws. His series was 63-1/4, 67-2 1/2, 65-3/4, 66-8 1/2, 65-7 3/4 and 64-3 1/2. He also won the discus with a throw of 191-3, but has a better state leading mark of 193-6.

McBroom tied Jesse Owens' alltime mark of 10.3, first set in 1932. Second was Ron Bonner of Dayton Jefferson in 10.5 and third was 10.6.

McBroom shared the spotlight with sophomore Lavonna Martin of Trotwood Madison at the Roosevelt Memorial meet

in Dayton's Welcome Stadium.

Martin tied the national record in the 100 meter low hurdles on 13.6, breaking the all-Ohio mark of 14.0 first set by Dawn Noel of Celina in 1978.

Martin also won the 200 in 24.6 and 400 in 56.1.

In the same meet, Matt Vermillion of Twin Valley North set an Ohio Class A record when he cleared 15-6 1/2 in the pole vault.

"I really wanted it today," said Vermillion who will graduate at the head of his class with a straight A average.

Vermillion, who has cleared 16-0 indoors this winter, plans to major in computer science in college and will attend either Indiana, Kansas State or Miami.

Jaye Bailey of Wehrle cleared 7-0 in the high jump. He barely missed on three tries at 7-1 1/2, which would have broken the state prep record. He also won the long jump at 22-3 1/4.

Laron Brown of Dayton Roth had a good day, winning the 200 in 21.1 and 400 in 46.8. Both are top marks in Ohio this year.

Tom Wilcher of Detroit Cen-

tral won the 110 highs in 13.6 with Kevin McKinley of Cleveland John Adams next at 13.8.

Detroit Central won the 1600 relay in 3:12.7, with Cleveland Lincoln-West second with 3:19.8 and Roth, which has three relaymen injured, third in 3:20.3.

The Dayton meet produced two all-Ohio marks, one was tied and one national mark was equalled as 4,100 fans watched the "Speed Show"
