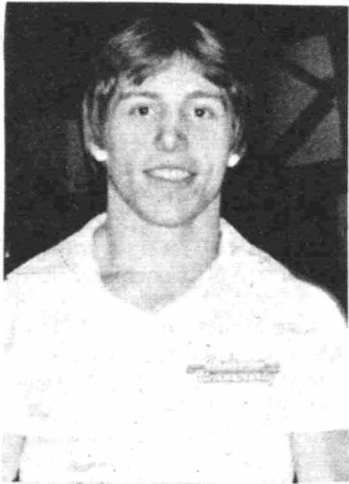

## Matt Vermillion Sets All-Time Ohio Pole Vault Mark with 16-3/4

Matt Vermillion, a straight 'A' student at Twin Valley North, now owns both alltime Ohio pole vault records.

The 5-7, 139-pound senior added the outdoor record when he sailed 16-3/4 on May 11 at the Twin Valley Invitational meet held at Twin Valley South's Field since North has no track.

Vermillion, who holds the all-time Ohio indoor record with 15-7, cleared his record height on his first try last week. He is only the second vaulter to clear 16-feet in Ohio prep history.

Matt bettered the alltime Ohio mark of 16-0 set by Les West of Dayton Wayne in 1975. After clearing 16-3/4, Vermillion then went to a new pole and "couldn't do anything," as he missed three times at 16-6.

"My winning jump wasn't all that good. It was technically poor," Vermillion said. "I'm ready to go higher. I'm ready to pop a 17-footer. It's there. Physically I'm ready, but mentally it's a barrier. I have the potential to go 17 feet."

Vermillion has not made a choice on a college. He says he is considering Miami, O., and Indiana. He will defend his state Class 'A' title on June 4-5 in Ohio Stadium in Columbus. Last year he cleared

14-3 in the state meet. He appears certain to break the state meet record of 14-9 1/2 held by Roger Gilders of Albany Alexander set in 1976.

Cleveland Heights' well-balanced track team continues to dominate the big meets this season. The terrific Tigers won the first Ned Weingart Relays on Heights' new, all-weather track last Saturday by amassing 116 points. Bedford Chanel was a strong second with 116 and third was Dayton Roth, last year's AAA state champion, with 110.

John Hawthorne was Heights' outstanding performer, winning the 100 meters in 10.8, running on the second-place 1,600-meter relay and fourth place sprint medley and taking the 300-meter low hurdles in 37.8.

Junior sprint ace Willie Clark accounted for 25 points to lead Sandusky to the 15th Buckeye Conference crown last Saturday. Clark accounted for 25 points by winning the 100 in 11.0, the 200 in 22.5 and running on the winning 400 and 1600-meter relay teams

Miami University held its last dual meet on antiquated Miami Stadium last Saturday and bombed rival Ohio U., 101-61. Miami's Jeff Ward set a school, field and alltime Ohio college pole vault record with a leap of 18-0 3/4.
