Walsh Jesuit Runs 4th Fastest 3,200 Relay, 7:47.5

Last week's district track and field meets, the first step leading to the state meet finals of 1:55.2 and McCarty 1:55.3 on the anchor. Gollias came back and won the 1,600 in on June 4-5 in Columbus, proved Ohio's prep stars are in rare form. The momentum built a converted time of 4:19.7. up last week should be carried over to the 16 regional sites which will determine 1,536 individual and relay qualifiers for the big showdown in Ohio Stadium in two weeks.

The addition of the 3,200-meter relay for boys is sure to produce plenty of fireworks after Walsh Jesuit, Akron Buchtel and Lorain Admiral King turned in the three fastest clockings of the season. Walsh had a converted time of 7:47.5 in winning its event in the Kent Roosevelt District and Buchtel had 7:52.7. In the Elyria District, Lorain Admiral King ran 7:53.2 on a metric track. The Roosevelt meet was run in yards.

Walsh's time is the fourth fastest nationally this season. The Warriors' time was 7:50.3

in yards and converts to 7:47.5 in metric.

Paul Volpe, Chris Holt, Bob Gollias and Dave McCarty ran for Walsh. Gollias had a split he took the 800 in 1:55.7 and the 1 600 in 4 16 2

Cleveland Heights, which looms as the early favorite to capture the AAA state crown, won the Case Western Reserve District with 194 points as the Tigers qualified 15 individuals and all three relays for the Austintown Fitch Regional this week Sprinter John Hawthorne passed up the low hurdles and instead qualified in the 100 (10.8) 200 (21.8) and 400 (49.0).

In the other Cleveland district meet at Rocky River, St. Ignatius successfuly defended its title with 77 points as nine records were set and another equalled. Brian Scruggs of Lincoln-West won the 200 in 21.4 and the 400 in 49.0 while Belfred Clark of Marshall won the two hurdles in 14.4 and 38 0 Rob Juergens of River won a fine distance double as

Dayton Roth, Wehrle in Regional Showdown

The showdown everyone has been waiting for between Class AA powers Dayton Roth and Columbus Wehrle will take place this week in the Dayton Regional at Welcome Stadium. Both teams are loaded with talent and both have some injuries

Roth came out of its district qualifier last week with 13 individuals and all three relays advancing. Wehrle will bring 11 individuals and two relay teams, and the survivor will be the odds on favorite to win the state crown on June 4-5 in Columbus

Roth qualified two individuals in the 100, 200, 400, 800 and the high hurdles. Wehrle has two each in the 100, 200, high and low hur-

"We're in a helpless situation with Roth being so strong," said Wehrle Coach Bob Fowle. "They have everybody back from last year. If we had Joe Banks (out with a pulled hamstring), we could give Roth a run.

Wehrle's big threat now will be sprinter Kevin McBroom in the 100 and 200 dashes, events which he won in last year s state title. The key for Wehrle could be Jaye Bailey who has long jumped 23-41/2 and high-jumped 7-0. In the district he tried for an all Ohio record of 7-11/4 but missed three times.

Lurking in the background at Dayton is another formidable team Jefferson, which qualified eight individuals and all three relay teams. The two leading Class A contenders in the Dayton area will fight it out Dayton Christian and Jamestown Greeneview .

Barry Walker led Lancaster to a one sided victory in the Athens AAA District by winning the shot with 66-10% and the discus with 181-4 as the Gales piled up 149 points. Miami Trace was runnerup with 105 points. Rob Marsh took the high jump with a leap of 6-7. He also qualified in the high hurdles The Gales qualified nine individuals and the 3,200 relay for this week's regional at Mt. Vernon.

Walker is slated to participate in three post-season meets the Golden West, National Junior at Bloomington, Ind., and the International Prep at Napierville, Ill.

Patty Metzler, the Class A defending 1,600-meter champion, improved here state-leading time with 4:55.5 in last week's district meet. She also improved here 800 time with 2:21.0.

Two ranking Dayton performers were sidelined with injuries in the Dayton District. Roth high-jumper Kevin Johnson, who has cleared 6-5, slipped on the wet pavement during the prelims and injured his ankle He did not qualify for the regional. And sprinter Pat Whitlow of Wilbur Wright, pulled up lame in the 200 but qualified earlier in the 400. It poured at the meet.

Defending Class A boys champion Columbus Academy won the Central District title easily as senior Phil Cannon led with three individual titles. He won the 110 high hurdles in 14.9, the 300 lows in 38.6 and anchored the winning 1,600-meter relay, 3:28.0. Last Wednesday he won the long jump with 22-2 * * *

Upper Arlington swept to the AAA Central District crown with 114 points as Beth Bunge won the shot and discus and the Golden Bears also winning the high jump, 3200 relay.

Mifflin's Kellie Simpson won three events, the 100 in 11.6, the 200 in 24.5 andlong jump. Her 11.6 is t wo tenths of a second off the alltime Ohio metric record but betters the state meet record of 11.8.


