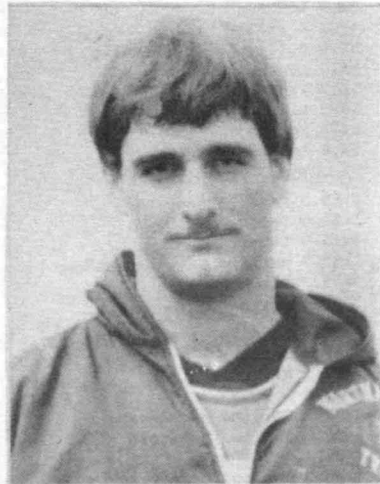

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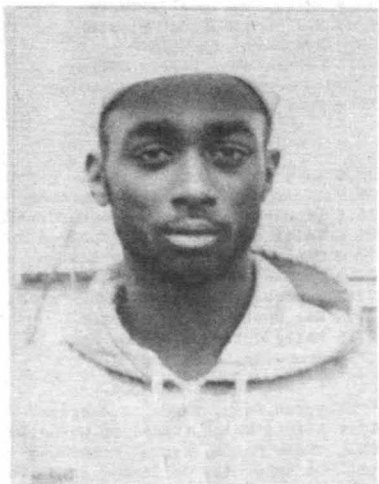
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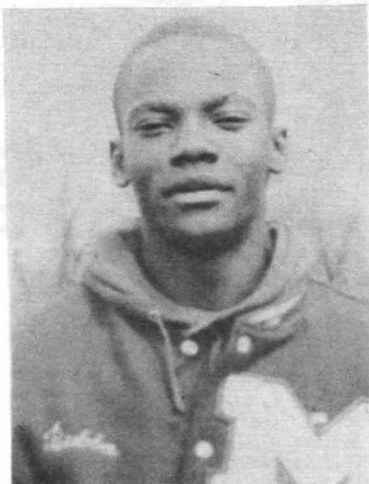

The record-breaking continues in Ohio as the Buckeye state's finest boys and girls start taking aim at the state championships.

Two All-Ohio records were set at the Dayton Relays last Friday when Dunbar romped to a clocking of 54.7 in the 400 meter shuttle hurdles. Upper Arlington broke the girls' 3,200 distance medley relay (800, 400, 400 and 1600) with 9:27.6.

Anchoring Dunbar's shuttle team was Michael Jackson.

At the Bellaire Relays, the Medina Buckeye girls ran a very excellent 1:50.54 in winning the sprint medley relay.
