## Dayton Dunbar Favored to win Boys AAA State Crown; Perkins is 'AA' choice and Wehrle is Pick in 'A'

COLUMBUS — Dayton Dunbar is expected to win the Class AAA boys state title here this weekend when the 77th boys' meet and the 10th girls' will be staged in Ohio Stadium.

Dunbar gets the edge over Akron Buchtel, Alliance, John Adams

and Columbus Beechcroft because it has the proven performers.

Hurdler Michael Jackson will be hard to beat. The Wolverines have sprinters Rod Twitty and David Lawrence, also qualifiers in the long jump, and their 400 and 1,600-meter relay teams.

Buchtel has point-potential

of 30-plus with its three relays and William McLane in the 800. Buchtel's 3200 foursome set a alltime Ohio record last week in the Austintown Regional, 7:45.9.

Alliance has the outstanding Lowell Terrell in the 1,600 and 3200, Marzett Hawkins in the 400 and Hawkins in the long

jump and Ken Pasoley in the high jump.

Beechcroft has two hurdlers, John Greenle and Ken Rankin, who also made it in the lows and long jumped 24-3/4 last week.

Adams has the great Harold Madox in the 200 and 400 dashes and its state-leading 1,600 relay, 3:13.8.

A close race is expected in Class AA, but Sandusky Perkins should edge Columbus Hartley. Perkins has sprinter Don Clark, distanceman Scott Fry and hurdler-high jumper Mark Speer each in two events.

Hartley hurdlers Ron Hobbs and Matt Sebenoler, along with dashman-long jumper Leigh Grey will make it formidable.

Columbus Wehrle is favored to retain the Class A title. It has defending hurdles champ Lewis Nowlin back and a good supporting cast.

In the three girls' divisions, Trotwood Madison gets the edge over Upper Arlington in AAA; Hartley should prevail in AA and Zanesville Rosecrans should keep its Class A crown because of sprinter-hurdler Chris McGee in three events and the in-

comparable Susan Nash in the 400 and 800. Minster will be a factor as usual because it has four strong relay teams and four quality individuals.

Theresa Diggs should be the big point-getter for Hartley. She has qualified in the 200 (26.58) and the 100LH, 12.75.

Hannibal River, with Jennifer Hyland, Sandy Valley and Sheridan figure to get points in AA.

LaVonna Martin has qualified in four events, 100, 200, 100LH and 300LH. Her times of 12.07 in the 100, 13.63 in the 100LH and 44.18 in the 300 LH are the best coming out of the regionals.

Upper Arlington qualified its 1600 relay (3:54.4), the best in the regionals; its outstanding 3200 relay, plus three individuals in four events.

Centerville will try to stay in the AAA chase with the outstanding Laura Kirkham in the hurdles and long jump.

All times in running events were made in regional finals last weekend. Faster times in prelims were not available from all sites to Ohio T&FN.

## Trickett establishes own identity as runner

DAYTON - Matt Trickett has solved his identity problem by going out and running consistently good times this season.

The Fairborn High senior finally emerged from under his brother's shadow. Last year, he was known as Andy Trickett's little brother.

Andy, who also ran for Fairborn, was the dominant distance runner in the area in 1982, finishing second in the state Class AAA, 1,600-meter run in 4:14.3. He was good enough to earn a scholarship to the University of Texas.

But Matt's talent quickly became evident last year when he finished second in the AAA 1600 meter run. He was fourth in the state cross country meet last fall and once he got into gear he started to post impressive marks, such as the 1:55.5 in the 800 and 4:20.5 in the 1,600 he did in the District Meet.

He's also part of Fairborn's 3,200-meter relay which has been among the state's leaders, posting 7:58.1.

Trickett said he has been concentrating on the 800 and 1600 runs this season after running mostly the 3,200 in 1983.

Trickett announced he will enroll at LSU. "I thought about

going to Texas with my brother," Trickett said, "but Texas wouldn't give me a straight answer about whether they were going to have any foreign distance runners or not. That makes the competition pretty tough.

"LSU won't have any foreign runners, which makes a lot of difference."

Trickett will be in the big horseshow at Ohio Stadium this weekend bidding for a state title.

**W. Geauga weightman posts best shot, 61-6 1/2**
**Zukowski becomes proficient**

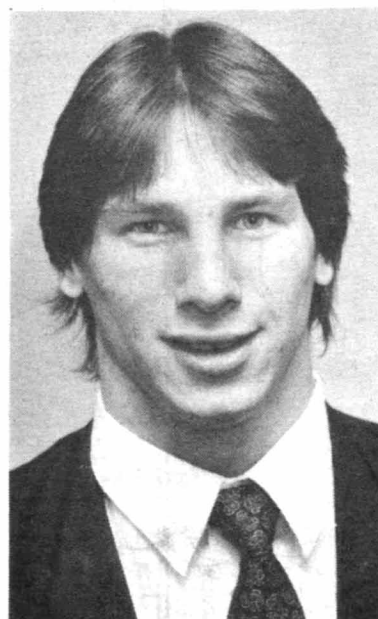
Rich Zukowski of West Geauga High knows how to throw his weight around. The 6-2 1/2, 215-pound senior became so proficient that he authored a 61-6 1/2 shot put throw in the Euclid District Meet, the longest in AAA this season in the state. He has been in the 60-foot range all season.

Zukowski also has a ranking discus mark, 178-1, which makes him a contender for a state title in two weight events this weekend in Columbus.

Zukowski is not hampered by his "small" size. "I think too much size hinders a person," Zukowski told News-Herald sports writer Joe Magill the other day.

"You have to have the quickness and the technique. I feel smaller and faster and stronger is better. I feel perfect where I am now. I feel I'm quick enough and strong enough."

There's confidence on the team about Zukowski's state title chances. "We feel he's got

a good chance at the state," said Coach Roy Podojil.

Zukowski placed sixth in the state in both weight events last year, and everyone concerned feels he has made strides since then.

"I want to win the state in both events," Zukowski said. "I know what I'm capable of. Right now I feel better in the shot."

If Zukowski succeeds in the state meet, he'll be West Geauga's second state champion in three years. Chris McKenzie won the girls AAA shot put in 1981.

"She's the one who got started," Zukowski said. "I was friends with her brother and she got me going in the sport."

Last winter Zukowski accepted a football scholarship to Illinois State University. He was wooed by Ohio State, Penn State, Michigan, Clemson and Notre Dame, but chose the smaller Division 1-AA school because of its size.

"I felt I might get lost in the shuffle at the bigger schools," he said. "I also thought I'd have a better chance of playing at a smaller school. You get more one-on-one attention."

**Huber eyes 800 State meet repeat**

St. Ignatius High's defending Ohio Class AAA 800-meter run champion Mike Huber has run a long way since he was spotted lapping the field when he was running laps as a Wildcat freshman football player.

The 6-2, 160-pound senior has established himself as one of the nation's premier distance runners. In early May he ran the fastest time in the country in his specialty, a sparkling 1:51.5, at Miami University's Ryder Relays.

Huber, who already has accepted a scholarship to Georgetown University, where he plans to study a pre-med course, is hoping to help the Wildcats keep the state Class AAA 3,200-meter relay crown at the state meet this weekend.

"Mike is an extremely talented young man," said St. Ignatius coach Chuck Kyle, also the school's head football coach. It was Kyle who recognized

Huber's running talents when he was playing freshman football.

"Mike caught your eye the first time you saw him," Kyle said. "We were doing a mile for conditioning. There were 120 kids out there and there was this young kid lapping everybody."

"When he finished I walked over to him and told him that he ought to go out for track. Well, after football he played basketball and in the spring he came out for track."

"He first ran the hurdles and was undefeated. In our ninth grade program we experiment, so Huber tried the 800."

"Mike ran a 2:08 and something like a 2:03 at the end of the season. As a sophomore he ran a 1:55 and anchored the 3,200 relay to second in the state

meet. Last spring he won the state 800 with 1:52.91.

"Mike has not lost in the 800 since his sophomore season when he was about ninth in the state meet."

Huber won the 800 (1:54.3) at the prestigious Mansfield Relays in April. "This is the first step toward defending the state championship," he said.

Huber also is scheduled to run for the Ohio team in the Midwest Meet of Champions, June 9 in Fort Wayne, Ind., the Keebler International Prep near Chicago, June 16 and his 1:51.5 has qualified him for the Junior National Championships to be held in conjunction with the United States final Olympic track trials in Los Angeles Coliseum, June 16-24.

"Leigh is picking up right where he left off last year," says Hartley coach Joe Ramsey of the 5-8, 150-pound standout.

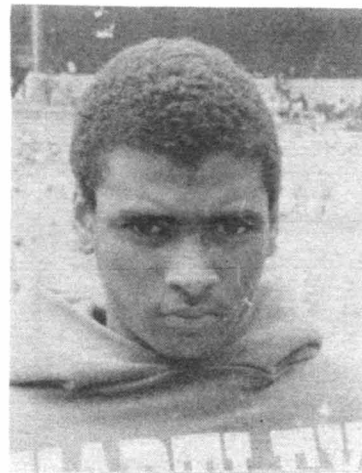
"Every time Leigh jumps, he wants to jump farther and he gets upset if he doesn't," says Ramsey.
