MIFFLIN PICKED FOR 'AAA' GIRLS CROWN; MINSTER IS 'A' CHOICE: 'AA' IS TOSS-UP

Cleveland Heights Favored to Win AAA State Crown; Dayton Roth is Choice in AA, Jamestown in Class A

COLUMBUS — The 75th boys and eighth girls state track and field championships this weekend can be labeled the "1982 Speed Show" after the swift clockings that have been posted the last two weeks in the District and Regional qualifying meets.

Record-breaking will be in abundance when 31 individual defending champions and relay teams converge on Ohio State's Ohio Stadium. Six alltime Ohio metric records already have been broken and more are due.

Picking the favorites to win the six championships is always risky but the staff of Ohio Track & Field News has made its choices.

Qualifying six quality people and its 400, 1600 and 3200 relay teams, Cleveland Heights is favored to win the boys' AAA team title. John Adams, with talented Kevin McKinley in both hurdles, Bill Jones in the 800 and its 1600 and 3200 relays, will be in contention.

"They'll be tough. McKinley will probably win the two hurdle races," said Cleveland Heights Coach Dick Mann.

"We have the point potential, but we have to do it on the track. The state meet is a chopper. This will be our best shot at the title since I've been at Heights."

Heights' previous best-ever showing under Mann was a third place in 1962 when Marty Eisner was the

standout in the shot put and discus throw.

Heights' outlook for the state title brightened when sprinter Brian Scruggs of Lincoln-West pulled up in the 100 and had to be scratched from the 200 and 400. Lincoln West's 400 and 1600 relays also went down the drain.

"That definitely helped us but we still have to do it," Mann said.

Heights has been invincible this season, winning eight major meets, plus the District and Regional titles.

Scruggs' loss was a blow to Lincoln-West since the Ohio State-bound dashman had the leading times in the 100, 200 and 400 in Class AAA this season.

Trotwood Madison, with sprinter-hurdler Kevin Lyons; Dayton Patterson, Lancaster, Mansfield Malabar and Lorain Admiral King should finish among the top 10 teams.

King's 3200 relay authored an alltime Ohio record of 7:48.4 in last week's Amherst Steele Regional.

Dayton Roth, winner of the AAA crown last year, has 11 runners and three relays and is a shoo-in to win

the AA title this time. Sprinter Laron Brown is Roth's key performer.

Columbus Wehrle, last year's AA champ, and Dayton Jefferson should battle it out for second place.

Jamestown Greeneview rates the edge over Dayton Christian and defending champion Columbus Academy in Class A. Phil Cannon is Academy's workhorse.

On the distaff side, Columbus Mifflin looms as the runaway for the girls' AAA crown, but Upper Arlington, Dayton Patterson and defending champ Centerville will contend.

Sprinter Kellie Simpson has the fastest times in the 100 (11.9) and 200 (24.4) in the state and she also has qualified in the long jump by spanning 17-10 1/4.

Sunbury Big Walnut is the pick over Columbus East and St. Clairsville in AA. Minster is a heavy favorite to win its sixth title in the last eight years. Defending champion Zanesville Rosecrans will make a bid.

Freshman Laura Kirkham of Centerville has tied the alltime Ohio long jump record when she leaped 19-4 1/4 last week at the Dayton Regional. She had two other jumps over 19 feet.

La Vonna Martin, Trotwood Madison's talented sophomore hurdler, will be in the stands watching the state meet finals. She had to scratch from the Dayton Regional finals after becoming ill due to an allergy to milk products. Unofficial qualifiers on pages 4-5-6-7.

Ohio Athletics Congress Plans 12 District Meets

The Ohio Athletics Congress is gearing up for the expected 3,000 athletes who will participate in this summer's Junior Olympic track and field championship.

Greatly expanded from the old AAU format, the Ohio Athletics Congress (OAC) will sanction 12 district Junior Olympic meets. Each meet will afford an opportunity for boys and girls ages 8 to 18 to compete or to develop their talents as did last year's national J.O. champs from the Buckeye state, Ken Daily (Beaver Creek, 500m) and Jamie Melfi (Springfield RW).

Cost of entering district meets is \$1.00 per athlete. Awards will be presented to the top six athletes in each event, and the first three finishers will advance to the Ohio Junior Olympic Championships, July 3-4 at Carlisle, O.

There will 156 different events scheduled this season in Ohio. These events range from the 100-meter dash to the

5,000-meter run and include the triple jump and 400-meter hurdles. The 400, mile and two-mile relays are also scheduled.

The top three athletes for both boys and girls division in five age groups will advance from the Ohio J.O. meet to the six-state Region VI meet at Dayton's Welcome Stadium. From here the winner and runnerup in the 15-16 and 17-18 age groups advance to the National Junior Olympic championships at the University of Nebraska, July 30-Aug. 1.

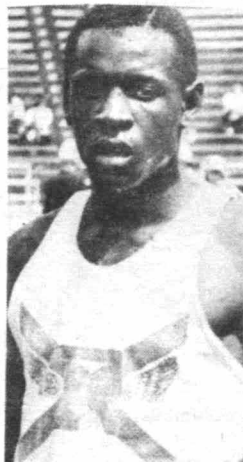

Triple crown

Roth's Laron Brown aims for 100, 200, 400

Roth's Laron Brown is a runner with simple goals this season. He merely wants to capture the state 100, 200 and 400-meter championships, set a national high school record in the 400-meters and help his school to the class AA state team championship.

Once those feats are accomplished, he wants to make the 1984 Olympic team in the 400-meters as well as become an All-American wide receiver before he graduates from Tennessee.

His dreams may seem a bit far-fetched as of now, but Brown has the ability to fulfill his wishes. Doing it, however, is another matter.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS in the 100, 200 and 400-meters are probably the most realistic. Last year he won state AAA titles in the 200 and 400 meters and was third in the 100. He helped Roth run away with the state AAA team title. This year the Falcons have dropped to AA and the competition isn't quite as tough.

As for a state team championship, Roth may be the strongest team in the Dayton area and could develop enough by state meet time to be unchallenged for the top spot. Brown has plenty of help in the sprints, distances and relays.

The national record for the 400-meters is 45.51 by Bill Green, now a junior at Southern Cal, in 1979. Brown's best time is 47.08 in the 400 last year. That time ranked him 15th among all high school runners in the nation last year and the fifth best among juniors. This year his best time is 47.7 which is currently the fourth best in the nation behind a trio of 47.5s turned by California runners.

"Going 45 flat is my goal," said Brown. "I hope to be around 46.5 or 46.6 by the Roosevelt Memorial (May 1) if the weather holds and then I'll take it from there. I think I can do it. I'd like to get that national record."

BROWN IS undoubtedly Ohio's best sprinter in the 200 and 400 meters. He is an effortless runner who has not been pushed in high school competition in the last two years.

He will be attending Tennessee on a football scholarship which will also allow him to run track. "Laron is the best middle distance sprinter among the high school seniors in the country," said Tennessee track coach Stan Huntsman. "There may be better runners in the 100, but in the 200 and 400 he is one of the best. He is good because he has great leg speed, good stride length, is excellent in the starting blocks and has great knowledge of his races. When you put that combination together you have a fine runner."

Tennessee was Brown's top choice of colleges although Iowa State and Pitt weren't far behind. "I'm glad I'm going to school on a football scholarship rather than just track because the football scholarship gives you more," said Brown. "Football is really my favorite sport. If I had to pick between it and track I'd probably take football. But I wanted a college that would let me play both football and run track."

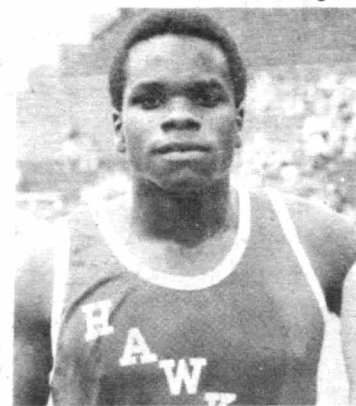
Over the years, Tennessee's sprint corps has been made up of wide receivers on its football team. "We find it a very compatible situation between myself and John Majors (Tennessee football coach)," said Huntsman. "We've been able to use the talents of the athletes in both areas and it has benefitted both of our programs. That is one of the things we stress with a lot of sprinters is that they can play football as well as run track. That was one of the major factors which helped us get Laron."

Roth track coach Randy Waggoner has been watching runners in Dayton since 1959. "Laron is the best I've ever seen," said Waggoner. "He is good because he is trained as a 400-meter runner who can also run the 100 and 200. He could be the best 800-meter man around if he wanted to be."

"He's good because of a lot of things beginning with his God-given ability. His father was a good high school runner and so was his uncle so it runs in his blood. He is a hard worker and isn't afraid to train and will keep training. You can't say that for other runners. He knows his race and his ability and he has the desire to win and be the best. When you have that you have a good one."

BROWN BEGAN running the 400-meters in age group track at the urging of Vernon Saine of the First Dayton Track Club. "Mr. Saine came up to me in the sixth grade and told me I should run the 400," said Brown.

"Mr. Saine showed me how to run the race and Randy has shown me how to be a winner. They have really helped me become the runner I am along with my teammates because they are always pushing me to become better."

Hamilton Rates Versatile Tag

CLEVELAND — Despite the lack of practice time, Hawken High senior three-sport star Eric Hamilton has made a big splash.

Hamilton, the defending Class A champion at 800 meters who is headed for Penn State on a football scholarship with a design to play wide receiver, is Mr. Versatility on the track.

He has run the 100, 200, 400 and 800 meters and has anchored the 400, 1600 and 3200 meter relay teams for the Hawks.

"I practice less for track than I did in basketball and football," said Hamilton, a 10-letterman and the first Hawken athlete to earn a major college athletic scholarship.

Hamilton will be making his fourth appearance at the state meet in Ohio Stadium this weekend.

As a freshman he had the best time in the state in the 800 but he false-started and was disqualified. As a 10th grader, he was second in the 400 in 49.5. As an 11th grader, he won the 800 and anchored the 1600-meter relay which placed fourth.

Hamilton is already preparing for the days when the cheering ends. He says he plans to star in two ways when he becomes a Nittany Lion: first in the classroom and then on the field.

"I picked Penn State over Miami (O) and Maryland because I liked the campus and wanted to go to a large school," said the 6-1, 180-pound, 18-year-old senior.

Hamilton, who plans to major in business with emphasis on accounting, will go out for the Penn State track team if his scholastic work load permits and that is good news for Track Coach Harry Groves.

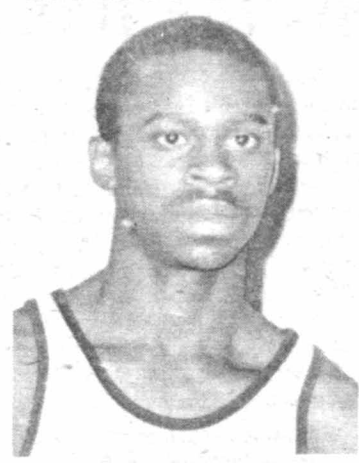

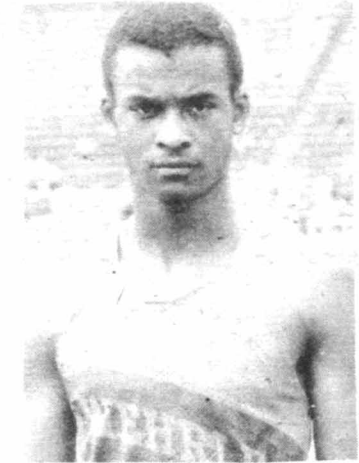

"I think getting tired is in my head. Before a race I get very nervous. Then I think I ran a bad race. When I get to the finish line and find out I ran good, a good time, I start crying. It's very emotional."

No one, not her coach Ray Beck or Martin herself, thought she would match Carol Lewis' national record so early in the season. (April 26)

"The 13.6 was a total surprise," said Beck, in his first year as head coach. "But definitely a pleasant surprise."

Two freshmen at AA Perry in Lake County did well in the District meet Pymatuning. Joe Medlan finished fourth in the 3,200 in 10:09.4, and Bill Meredith was third in the discus with 149-10.

"This is the first year my form and speed have come along," Martin said.

La Vonna said she has been lucky to avoid injury this year — except for one minor complaint.

"I got cramps in my legs wearing high heels in school," she said. "So my mother went out and bought me some flats."

The only problem for Martin now is finding someone to give her some competition.

"Who knows how fast she'd be if she had somebody pressuring her," Beck said.
