

Dover tracksters roll to win over Ashland

The Dover High boys' track team jogged past Cardinal Conference opponent Ashland 90-42 in a dual meet at Crater Stadium Wednesday.

The Tornados, 4-2 for the season, swept the field events led by Todd Altier's first places in the shot put and discus.

Three members of Dover's 400-meter relay team were double winners. Greg Arbogast also won the 400, Chris Mills claimed the 200 and Bryan Miller was first in the high jump.

In girls' action from Tuesday, Cadiz was sixth out of seven in the Ohio Valley Track League at Shadyside with 26 points. John Marshall, W.Va, won the meet

with 124½ points.

For the Cardinals, Greta Peterson won the 100-meter dash in 12.8 seconds and the long jump with a leap of 15-feet-3½. Tammy Carter was fourth in the low hurdles, and Cadiz placed sixth in the 400 relay.
