Zanesville romps in Dover meet

Powerful Zanesville spoiled Dover's 1981 track debut by outpoin-ting both the Tornadoes and Coshoc-ton in a triangular meet Tuesday at Crater Stadium.

Zanesville ran up 11 firsts in the 15 events for 76 points compared with 50 for Dover and 33 for Coshocton.

John Thomas won the long jump, high hurdles and low hurdles to lead the Blue Devils while Paul Belknap claimed the 200 and 400 races. inner

Rick Wilson was a double-wir for Coshocton in the 1600 and 3200.

The only Dover firsts were by Todd Altier in the shot put and Dan Van Epps in the high jump. "We're coming along," said Tornado mentor Jim Heller, noting that his team had a much tougher time of it in the same meet a year

Dover's Steve Truchly went 20-9½ in the long jump for a close second to Thomas' winning 21-3. Truchly also was second in the high hurdles.

Heller also praised the second-place efforts of John Denning in the 1600, Scott Heller in the pole vault and the 400 relay unit of Chris Hutras, Chris Mills, Bruno Frank and Mike Dickens.

IN OTHER AREA boys' track ac-tion Tuesday, Carrollton got four firsts from Todd Kohler but it wasn't enough as host Sandy Valley preenough as vailed 83-44.

Kohler won the long jump, 200 and both hurdle events to account for 20 of Carrollton's points and all but two of the Warrior firsts.

Sandy Valley was led by Rod McDade, who won the 100 and an-chored both winning relay squads.

Visiting Massillon raced past New Philadelphia 84-43. It was the first meet of the year for the Tigers while New Philadelphia fell to 1-1. Dave Cox led the host Quakers with firsts in the mile and two-mile.
