



MASTER CARVER'S NEWEST PROJECT. Dover's famed Ernest (Mooney) Warther is combining his unique carving talent with his interest in Abraham Lincoln to create his current train model, the Lincoln Funeral Train which bore the president's body from Washington to Springfield, Ill. The engine and 3 coaches, including the large private coach which was designed for Lincoln but never used before his death, are carved from hippopotamus ivory tusks and ebony and exact in minute

detail. The train, proclaimed by Warther as his "last," was begun last April 14 and is scheduled for completion this April 14, the 100th anniversary of Lincoln's assassination. An "unveiling" program is scheduled at the new Warther Museum on that date.
