



Rapid run...

It took Fred Nixon and Joe Krantz, members of the Dover fire department's emergency crew, only three minutes and two seconds to respond at 2 p.m. Thursday to a mock emergency at the Dover city pool. The run was part of a training program for lifeguards at the pool, but firemen treated it as a fullblown

emergency to receive accurate timing. Traffic stopped the emergency truck three times. The drill was arranged through Russ McGlothlin, pool director. The "victim," who suffered simulated head and back injuries, had to be strapped to a board and removed from the pool by the lifeguards and then the firemen "talked through" the rescue.
