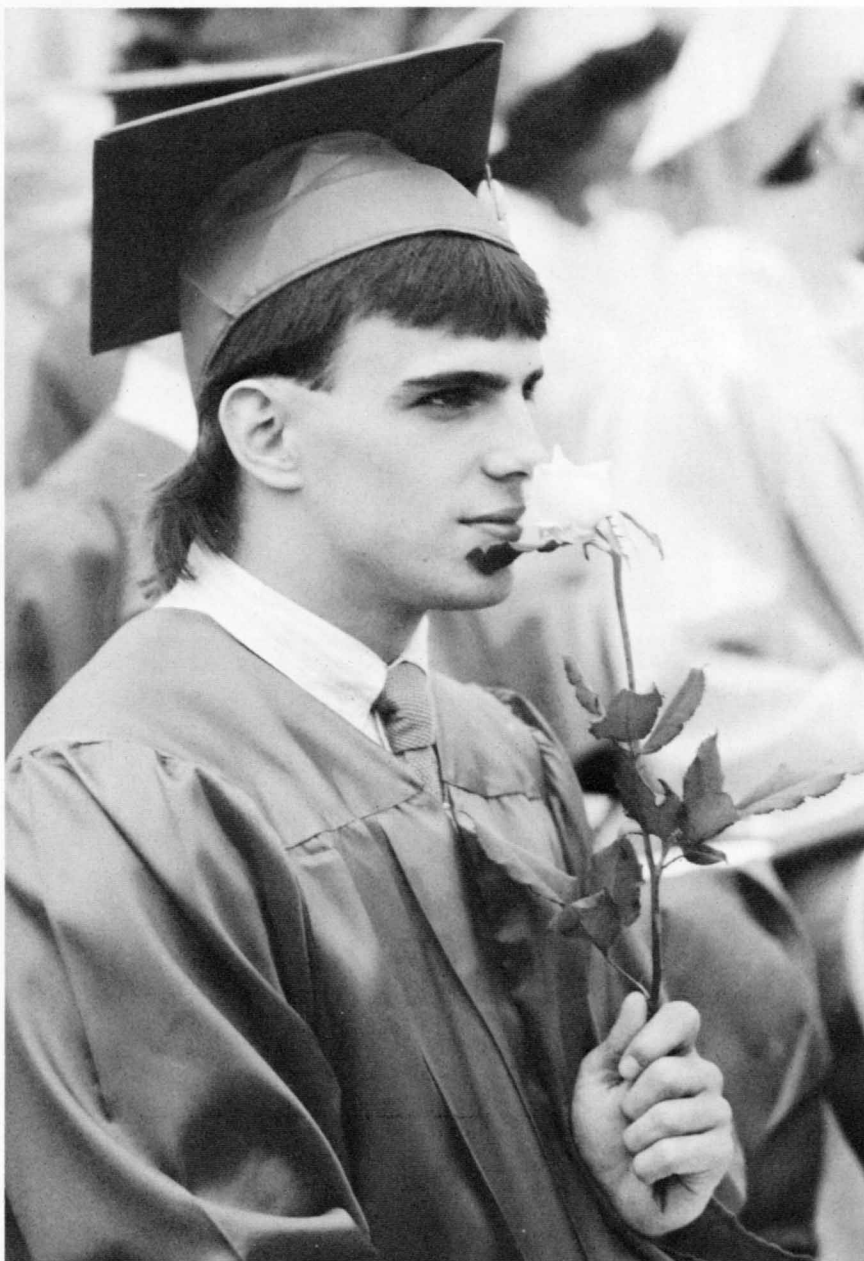


Graduation . . . A Time Of Mixed Emotions

"We Can!"

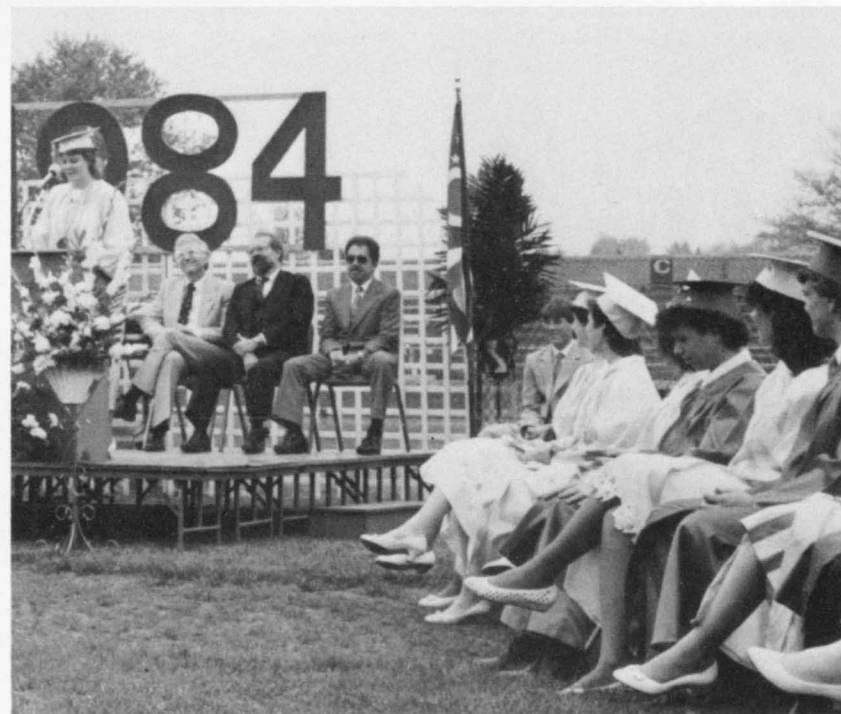
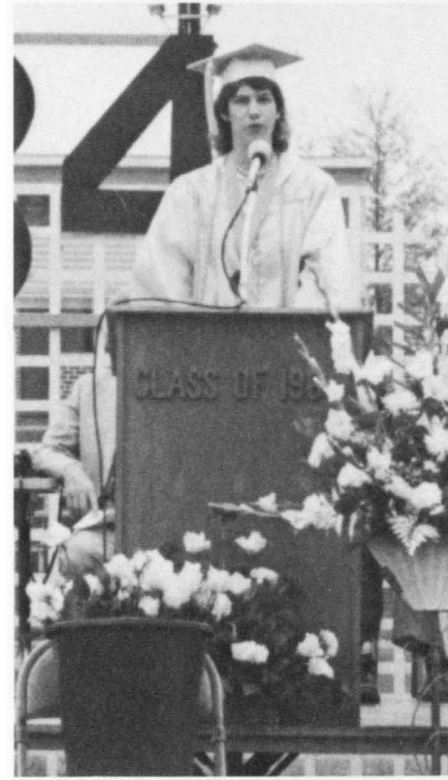

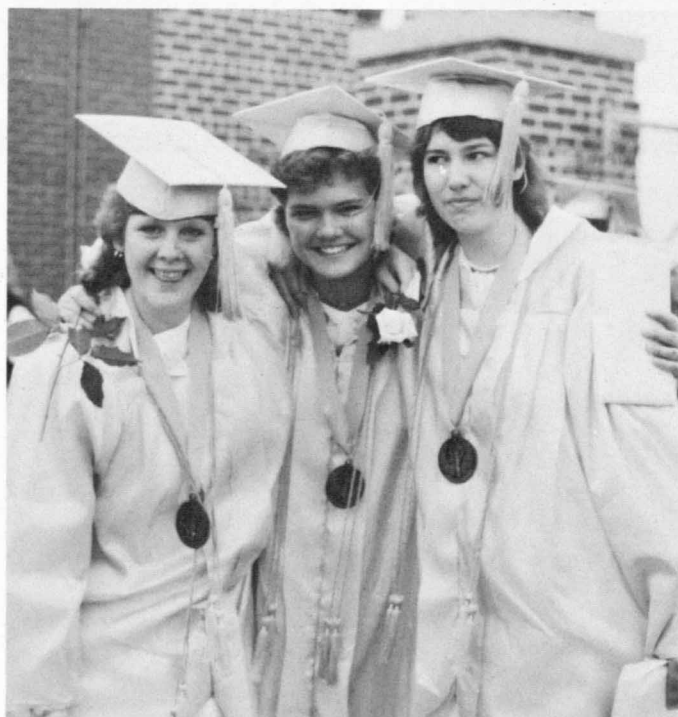
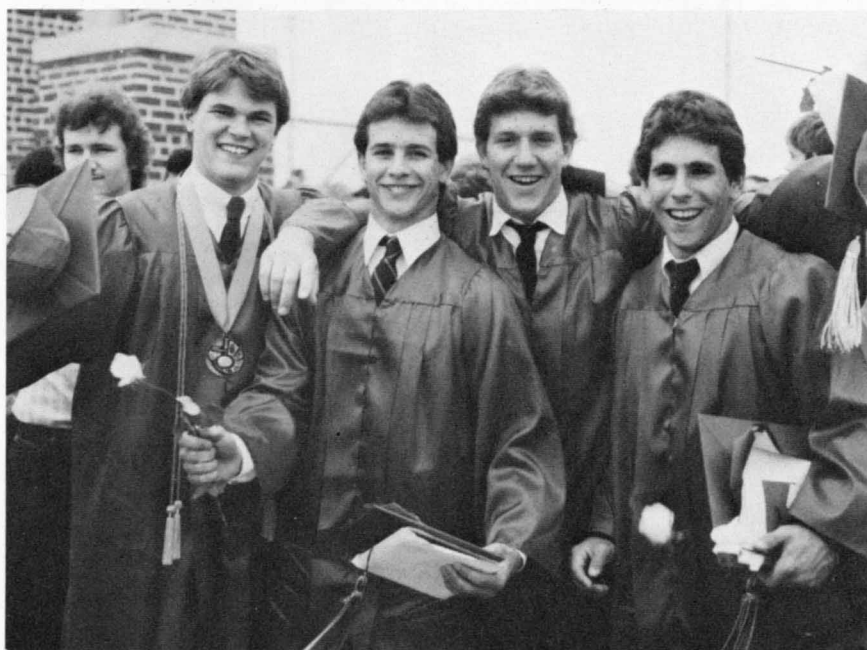
